	COM approves the Position Description
	Session requests permission from COM to form a Associate Pastor Nominating Committee (APNC)
	COM Liaison reviews pastoral search process with Session
	COM gives permission for congregation to elect an APNC
	When nominees are secured, Session calls a meeting of congregation to elect APNC
	-Congregation elects APNC
	COM Liaison orients APNC to the search process, and works with APNC in preparing -Ministry Information Form (MIF)
	COM reviews completed MIF; makes recommendations as needed
	Session approves the MIF
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	COM provides login/password to APNC for placing MIF on the PCUSA web site
	APNC receives Personal Information Forms (PIF), reviews them, interviews candidates
	COM Liaison requests Presbytery reference checks on final 3 or 4 candidates
	COM Liaison interviews final candidates who are brought into area and secures Criminal Background check on final candidates
	APNC selects the final candidate and negotiates terms of call
	COM approves the terms of call
	APNC requests permission from COM to ask Session to call a Congregational Mtg for a specific date in order to hear and act on the report of the APNC

	_Session acts to call a Congregational Meeting
	On that date, the Candidate preaches in worship, then the congregational meeting is held for approving the Call to the Associate Pastor
	COM presents the Call to Detroit Presbytery for concurrence. If the individual is a Teaching Elder from another Presbytery or a Candidate for Ministry, they would have an examination on the floor of Presbytery.
	The Pastor begins ministry, sets date for Service of Ordination and/orInstallation, secures Commission
	Presbytery approves the Administrative Commission and Installation date
